## ADDENDUM #2 TO 2022-2025 AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO AND

## SACRAMENTO COUNTY PROBATION ASSOCIATION FOR THE SUPERVISING PROBATION OFFICER UNIT

The County of Sacramento ("County") and the Sacramento County Probation Association ("Association") make the following agreement adding Article 7, Section 7.5 e., and f. and amending Article 15 of the 2022-2025 Agreement Covering All Employees in the Supervising Probation Officer Unit:

## 7.5 Salary Increases

- e. Effective <u>June 29, 2025</u>, salaries shall be increased based on the average percent of year to year change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) U.S. City Average, Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers reported to the nearest one-tenth of one percent (1/10%); however, such increase shall not be less than one percent (1%) or more than four percent (4%).
- f. Effective <u>June 28, 2026</u>, salaries shall be increased based on the average percent of year to year change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) U.S. City Average, Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers reported to the nearest one-tenth of one percent (1/10%); however, such increase shall not be less than one percent (1%) or more than four percent (4%).

## 15 Term

This agreement remains in full force and effective from June 19, 2022, to and including June 30, 2027.

All other provisions of Article 7, and the 2022-2025 Agreement Covering All Employees in the Supervising Probation Officer Unit are not affected by this addendum and shall remain in full force and effect unless and until a subsequent agreement is reached. This addendum and Addendum #1 shall remain in full force and effect unless and until a subsequent agreement is reached.
